BITH102 UNDERSTANDING THE NEW TESTAMENT

INTRODUCTION

This course is designed to introduce the New Testament. The student will examine major themes of the New Testament, broad divisions, key scriptures, major personalities, and the structure and context of each book within the New Testament. Literary and historical backgrounds are also examined throughout the study of Understanding the New Testament.

- Give a general outline of the history, prime characters, and Christian doctrine of the New Testament
- Understand the basic historical background of the NT and will be familiar with the lives and activities of Jesus and Paul.
- Understand how the various NT books fit in with the NT history and will have learned the basic contents of the NT books, along with brief outlines of the NT books.
