## **COURSE INTRODUCTION**

The many references to the Old Testament by Jesus during His earthly ministry illustrate the importance He placed on knowing the content of the Scriptures. Because Jesus stressed the importance of God's Word to the men He trained. This course will help to equip men and women to reach their nations with God's message.

The course introduces the Bible and discusses its translations and various versions. It presents an overview of Biblical history, geography, and life in Bible times of the Old Testament. The course provides an outline for each book of the Old Testament and teaches outlining skills for expanding these basic outlines into more detailed studies of God's Word.

Information presented on each Bible book includes the author, the people to whom the book was written, the purpose of the book, the key verse, a list of main characters, and an outline of the content. A life and ministry principle is also stated for each book of the Old Testament. These principles are basic truths vital to Christian maturity and ministry which you should seek to incorporate into your own life. Helpful charts, maps, and timelines summarizing important facts in condensed form are also included in this course.

The course provides introductory material on the Bible and outlines for the books of the Old Testament.
